Orama Public School Flood Plan



Orama Public School is on Darkwood Road. The road is subject to regular flooding due to low lying bridges. In the event of an imminent flood the following procedure should be followed:

- Check the river levels on the BOM website. Anything over 2.9m at Thora Bridge and the buses will not travel. Hobarts Bridge is the first bridge to close between Waterfall Way and the school. Richardson's Bridge is the first bridge to close further up Darkwood Road.
- 2. School to confirm action with bus companies
- 3. If in doubt ring Bellingen SES
- 4. Contact Director, Educational Leadership to communicate developments NOTE: FOR EVACUATION IT CAN TAKE UP TO ONE HOUR FOR BUSES TO ARRIVE
- 5. School to activate the distribution list on school mobile. Send message as per development (NON-OPERATIONAL or EVACUATION) and monitor those families who reply 'RECEIVED' to the message. Sample text messages below. Post same message (omit Reply RECEIVED to this message) on Facebook.
- 6. Call families with poor mobile reception.
- 7. Contact WHS Incident Report and Support
- 8. Contact Safety and Security
- 9. Contact Media Unit- Newcastle
- **10.** Update school website and Facebook page with an alert/post. Send BCC email to key stakeholders (parents, community members and staff) from school email.
