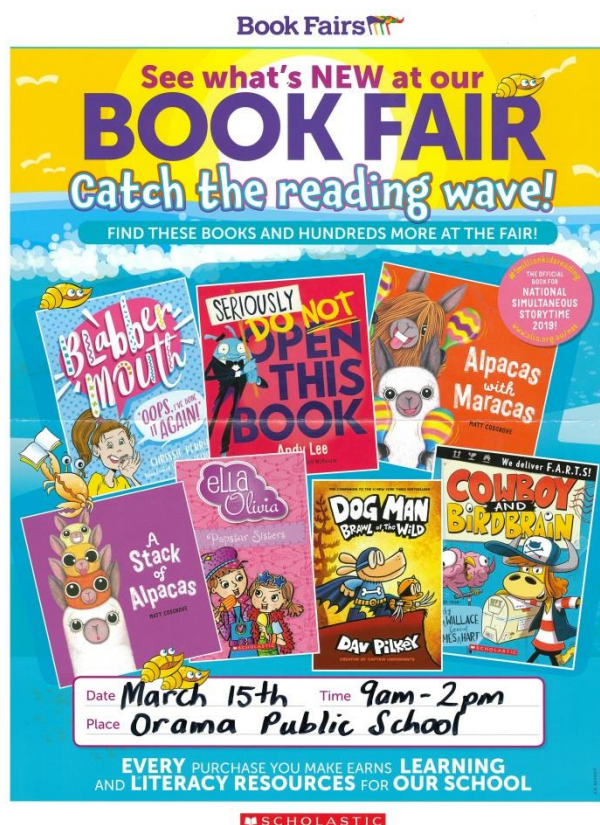


In 2017 our students came together to discuss characteristics and values that they feel are important at Orama Public School. The student led values are:

BELLINGEN FOOTBALL CLUB REGISTRATION

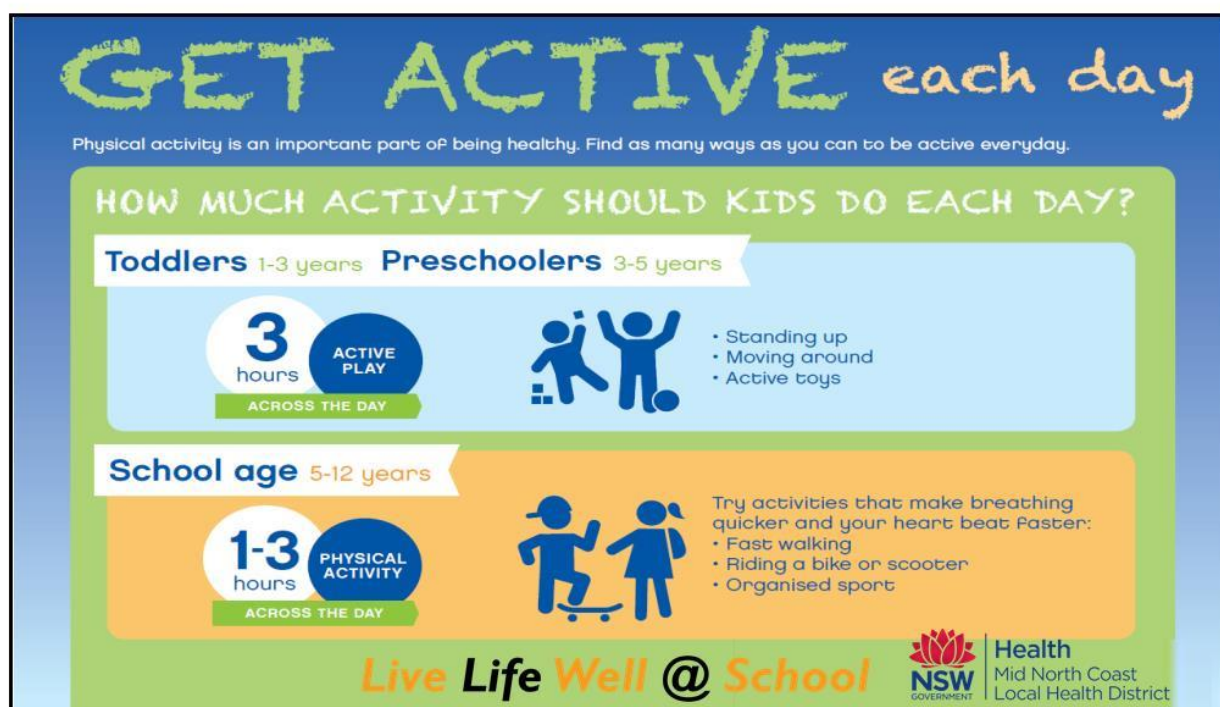
The 2019 football season is upon us and now is the time to register!
