We have some great initiatives planned for 2021.

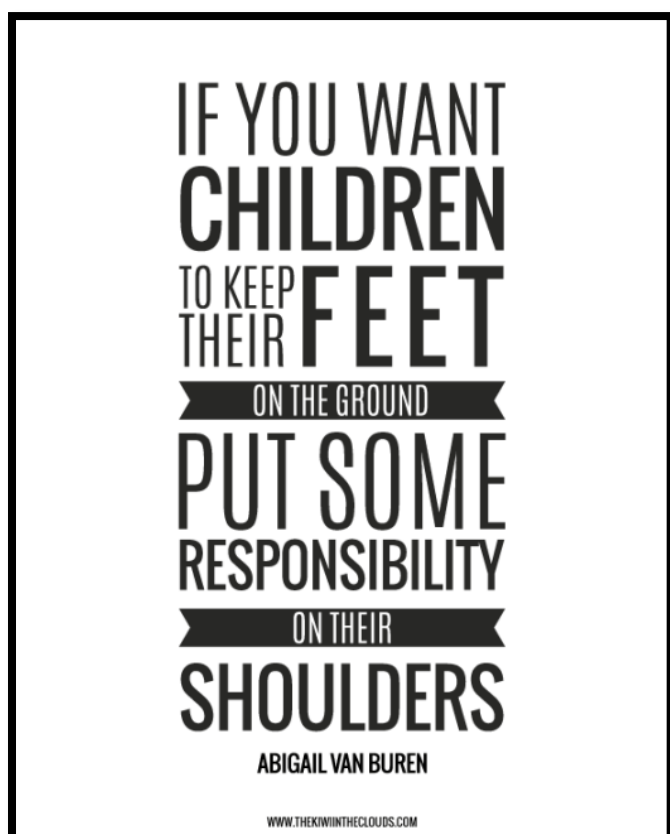
We will see Yrs 1-6 students on Friday January 29th and Kindergarten students on Monday February 1st, 2021.
