Bike Week



Applications for the CCS are made through your Centrelink online account through myGov. Please apply / update details for CCS if you haven't already done so. For more information on this process, visit education.gov.au/childcare</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: If children have a break between care of more than forteen weeks, their enrolment will be ceased. The Service will update enrolment details where necessary to assess CCS.</p>
