Assistant Principal Curriculum and Instruction (AP C&I)

The department has introduced a new Assistant Principal, Curriculum and Instruction position in all primary public schools. The leadership role is designed to work alongside Principals in providing high support to teachers in literacy and numeracy. They will work collaboratively in the implementation of the new English and mathematics Syllabus next year.

The AP C&I will provide guidance and professional learning to staff. They work alongside teachers in classrooms to enhance high quality teaching practices. This might look like demonstration lessons, team teaching or working with small groups of students in focussed literacy and numeracy tasks. Their role is dedicated to ensuring our students have strong literacy and numeracy knowledge. At Orama PS, in 2023, we will have an allocation of an AP C&I for one day a week. We are currently in the process of recruitment for the position.


